As summer begins to settle in around us, life takes on a different rhythm. School calendars fade into family vacations, camps, cookouts, late evenings, and changing schedules. For many, summer becomes a season of both opportunity and distraction. The routines that normally anchor us can loosen, and before we realize it, spiritual drift can quietly begin to happen. Yet summer can also become one of the most fruitful seasons of spiritual growth if we approach it intentionally.

God often uses the imagery of planting, growth, shepherding, and harvest to teach us about the spiritual life. Psalm 1:3 describes the faithful person as "like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season." Healthy growth does not happen overnight. Roots grow long before fruit appears, and much of God's deepest work happens quietly beneath the surface.

That is especially true as we think about the next generation. This month, we will gather for VBS as children learn about David, the shepherd boy who would one day become king. Long before David stood before Goliath or sat upon Israel's throne, God was shaping his heart in ordinary places. Faithfulness was formed in the fields while tending sheep. In many ways, that is still how spiritual formation works today.

June also marks the beginning of Confirmation for several of our students. Confirmation is not simply a class to complete, but an opportunity for young people to grow in their understanding of the faith and begin taking ownership of their walk with Christ. Just like VBS, these moments matter far more than we sometimes realize. Seeds are being planted that may bear fruit for decades to come.

This is why the role of families and the church matters so deeply. Parents, grandparents, teachers, volunteers, and church members all help shape the spiritual rhythms of the next generation. A prayer before bedtime, conversations about Scripture, faithful worship attendance, and gathering consistently with God's people may seem small in the moment, but God often uses ordinary faithfulness to accomplish extraordinary things over time.

As summer unfolds, I want to encourage our church family to remain connected through worship, prayer, Scripture, and Christian community even when schedules become scattered. Farmers understand that seeds planted faithfully in good soil do not produce a harvest overnight. Yet over time, roots deepen, growth emerges, and fruit begins to appear. The same is true spiritually. May we be faithful this summer to plant seeds that last, trusting that God is often doing His greatest work long before we can fully see the harvest.

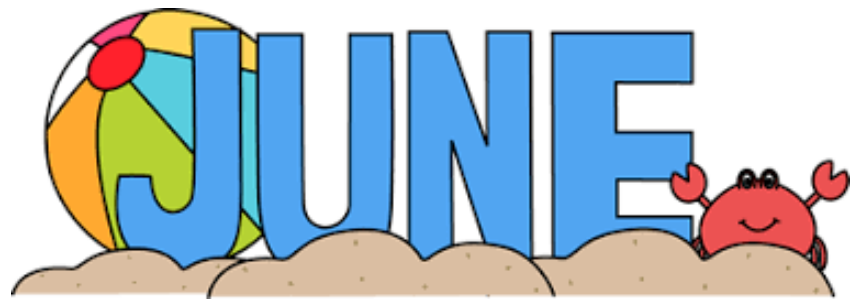

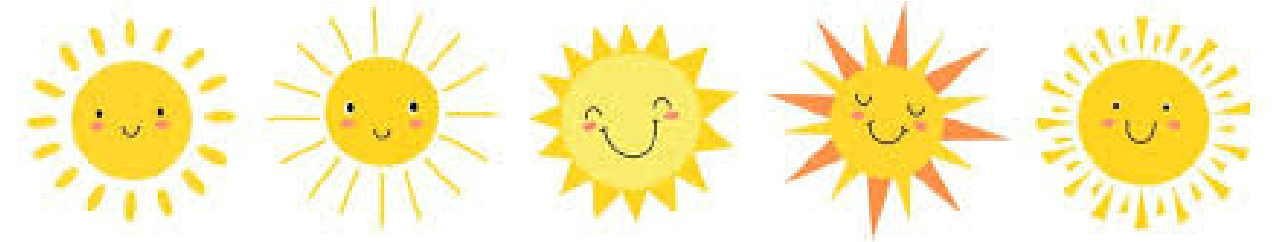
